



Three Campuses

UW-Stevens Point Campus

Founded in 1894, UW-Stevens Point is centrally located Stevens Point just outside of the city's downtown and connected to the 27-mile Green Circle Trail. Old Main, the university's original building, stands as the most recognizable landmark on campus. The iconic cupola atop the building shines purple and gold on special event days and for commencement and convocation. The university's academic buildings offer hands-on learning opportunities while the Noel Fine Arts Center offers community performances in Jenkins Theatre and Michelsen Concert Hall. Studentcentered facilities include the Dreyfus University Center, Marshfield Clinic Health System Champions Hall and the 280-acre Schmeekle Reserve.











Marshfield Campus

UW-Stevens Point at Marshfield fosters a community ranked as one of the best places to live and work, and home to one of the state's largest health care providers, Marshfield Clinic. Campus amenities include the 340-seat Helen Connor Laird Theatre, which hosts campus and community performances, and a 99-acre arboretum providing students and community members a great way to explore rare vegetation that once covered central Wisconsin.

In 2019, the Pointers men's hockey team became the first undefeated Division III national champions. In addition, many Pointers made it to the top of their games, including Terry Porter in the National Basketball Association, Clint Kriewaldt in the National Football League and Jordan Zimmermann in Major League Baseball. A new Pointers tradition began in the 2023-2024 academic year with the addition of men's volleyball and women's lacrosse.

We think what our student-athletes do off the courts, ice and fields means the most in preparing them as leaders in life. UW-Stevens Point is the proud recipient of the national award for public service among all of NCAA Division III—the largest college athletics division in America. The array of service our student-athletes provides is in keeping with the tradition of giving back that is so strong among all Pointers. Student athletes log thousands of hours of service, from building houses to reading to school kids, and raise close to \$50,000 through community games for charities, and more. University wide, nearly 2,000 students volunteer approximately 7,000 hours a semester. Measured in dollars, it is worth nearly \$150,000. Measured in lives transformed, it is priceless.



UW-Stevens Point's Schmeeckle (SHMEE-klee) Reserve is a 280-acre natural area maintained by the university to protect and restore native ecological communities of Central Wisconsin. It is an ideal place for hiking, jogging, biking, canoeing, fishing, wildlife watching and relaxing. The reserve has five miles of trails and boardwalks, a 25-acre lake, diversity of wildlife species, Visitors Center and gift shop. For hours and more information, go to www.uwsp.edu/ Schmeeckle.

Schmeeckle Reserve is one of four field stations operated by UW-Stevens Point across Wisconsin. Others include the Central Wisconsin Environmental Station in Amherst Junction, Northern Aquaculture Demonstration Facility in Bayfield and Treehaven in Tomahawk.




