Things to Do

Welcome to the Eastern Michigan University campus!

There's so much to see and enjoy while you're here, and we don't want you to miss a thing. Art exhibits, cultural events, concerts and sporting events offer exciting entertainment options and a way to live the EMU experience. Here are a few places we recommend that you check out during your stay.



University Park has picnic tables and space to get together with friends.

Go to University Park, watch the geese and swans, and enjoy the expansive view. Located in the center of EMU's campus, this beautiful 10-acre space features lakeside seating, a bridge, a gazebo, and a picnic pavilion. A one-mile jogging trail circles the lake, and there are also basketball courts and sand volleyball courts. In search of indoor space instead? The Lake House has a large stone fireplace, a big screen TV and casual seating. There's truly something for everyone in University Park.

Visit one (or more) of our three gallery spaces.

The Ford Gallery, located in Ford Hall, maintains

a year-round schedule of exhibitions and artist lectures. It serves as a venue for the work of outside artists and graduate thesis exhibitions, as well as undergraduate and graduate student exhibitions. The Student Center, on the north side of campus, houses two gallery spaces. The University Gallery features major exhibitions and events intended for the School of Art & Design, the campus community and the larger Ypsilanti community. A second gallery, directed by the student-run Intermedia Gallery Group, is dedicated to showcasing student work.




Catch a performance by the EMU choir throughout the year.

Walk the Art Trail. Start in the MLK Gardens on the south side of Ford Hall, located north of Cross Street, and look for artist Nancy Sippel's bust of Martin Luther King Jr. From there, you can follow the map at emich.edu/ art-trail to find 10 other impressive pieces, concluding with the sculpture "Lineage," by Charles McGee, located near the Student Center.

Are you a music lover? The School of Music and Dance produces more than 250 performances and presentations annually, with everything ranging from recitals to choir, jazz, wind symphony, symphonic band, and orchestra performances. Go to emich.edu/ music to find performances..

See the stars at the Sherzer Observatory.

See a Show. EMU Theatre annually produces six large-scale Mainstage productions and two small-scale experimental Second Stage productions. Recent shows include "James the Giant Peach," "9 to 5 The Musical," and "Peter and the Starcatcher." EMU Theatre is a pioneer in making theatre available to all patrons and offers services for guests who have hearing loss, are blind or have low vision. Visit the 9/11 Memorial in Pease Park, located on the south end of campus. There, a 14-foot beam from the south tower of the World Trade Center solemnly rests on a circular cement slab. In this tranquil setting, we remember the lives lost on Sept. 11, 2001, and honor the courage of the first responders who risked their lives to save others. The memorial is on Cross Street, between College Place and Perrin Street.

Hop on The Border-to-Border Trail (B2B), a 35-mile paved, shared-use path that runs along the Huron River and connects spaces in Washtenaw County, including Ypsilanti, Ann Arbor and Dexter. Hike, bike, jog or walk the trail as it meanders through parks and city centers. From the EMU campus, pick up the trail just south of the Village Apartments at Oakwood and Mayhew.

Grab your clubs and head over to the Roy E. Wilbanks Eagle Crest Golf Club, home of the EMU men's and women's golf teams. Ranked among the top 10 college courses in the U.S., Eagle Crest also has four new indoor simulation bays. Not a golfer? The Eagle Crest Bar & Grille offers great views of the course and a classic American menu featuring burgers, sandwiches, wraps and salads. Visit emich.edu/golf for tee times and grille hours.

Explore Ypsilanti, a culturally diverse community offering rich tradition, neighborhood shopping, museums, and unique annual events, like the Ypsilanti Jazz Festival. Just blocks away from campus you'll find historic Depot Town, an eclectic throwback shopping and restaurant district. Check out the weekly farmers market, grab a bite to eat at one of several restaurants, or walk to the Michigan Firehouse Museum. There are also many restaurants and shops downtown on Michigan Avenue.

HOUSING

On-campus housing options include residence halls and apartments, all offering a supportive and safe living-learning environment within walking distance of academic buildings, the library, and health and wellness opportunities. New and renovated living spaces feature air conditioning and enhanced Wi-Fi.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

Trinity Health Urgent Care sits at the corner of Oakwood and Huron River Drive. The health center provides 7-day-a-week primary care and urgent care services to the University's students and staff plus the greater community. EMU's Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS) are also free and available to address student's mental health needs. The newly renovated recreation building features cardio and weight room space, plus a club pool and an Olympic-sized pool.

GETTING AROUND

TheRide offers bus service to the greater Ypsilanti-Ann Arbor area, and Spin electric scooters are available to rent on campus.

History & Traditions




In 1849, the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Michigan established Michigan State Normal School, the first educator training school west of the Allegheny Mountains. Students studied the art of teaching, mechanic arts, agricultural chemistry and U.S. laws. EMU became a college in 1956 and a university in 1959.






THE COLLEGE OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
