## A Welcome from President Stokes


It is my sincere pleasure to welcome you to The University of New Mexico.

# TOP 10

## ADVENTURES WITHIN AN HOUR DRIVE FROM CAMPUS



### 1. KIWANIS CABIN

According to the United States Department of Agriculture, the cabin was built as an inclement weather shelter for the trail crews that worked to bring us Sandia's 28 hiking trails that are now used and loved by countless visitors. Its location on the western facing side of the mountain makes it the ideal place to watch the sunset over Albuquerque.



### 2. SANDIA PEAK TRAM

Climbing over a mile up the steep western face, the Sandia Peak Tram is the longest aerial tram in the United States and boasts some of the best views of any tram in the world. The ride runs about 15 minutes over three towers, while the car you ride in offers views looking down into the deep ravines hundreds of feet below. The tram is the best way to see the Sandias, especially getting to the top to witness the NM sunset.



### 3. BALLOON FIESTA

Arguably the most iconic event in the state, New Mexico hosts the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta every October. It is practically a rite-of-passage for all Lobos. Some are lucky enough to take a ride but, for millions of visitors, the visual experience of hundreds of balloons filling the sky is enough on its own. Attend the Mass Ascension to watch the balloons fly or take in the Twilight Twinkle Glow and After-Glow Firework Show at night.



### 4. 66 DINER

Just a few blocks west down Central Ave from campus, you'll find the 66 Diner.

Named after and located on the famous Route 66, the 66 Diner is brimming with nostalgic paraphernalia from decades gone by, with food that's just as classic. From the iconic milkshakes that come in every variety imaginable to the usual hallmarks of an American Diner, the menu offers a wide variety of mouth-watering meals.



### 5. RAIL YARDS MARKET

The Albuquerque Rail Yards Market is a weekly event through summer and fall that draws together growers, brewers, artists and more to share with the community what it is they love to do. Shopping for jewelry, fresh produce or simply enjoying a coffee with the sights are just a few of the things you can do here.



### 6. PETROGLYPH NATIONAL MONUMENT

*(photo from U.S. National Park Service)* Petroglyph National Monument is a 15 minute drive from campus and is one of the largest petroglyph sites in North America. These rock carvings are estimated to be 400-700 years old and offer a glimpse into New Mexico's past. Along with the petroglyphs, there are also several fun hiking and walking trails that offer an easy escape from the city.



### 7. EMPIRE BOARD GAME LIBRARY

Empire Board Game Library is the perfect place to kick back, relax, and spend a few hours in another world. Just a short walk from campus in Nob Hill, cozy up and battle out who the true meme queen or king is, who can best rule ancient Egypt, ward off some zombies, and more. Let's not forget to mention the incredible food and drink options to keep you feeling satisfied throughout your game.



### 8. TINKERTOWN

Reminiscent of a life-size Where's Waldo page, Tinkertown's enormous and eccentric collection of hand carved faces and figures gaze out in sheer wonderment at curious museum-goers. Explore the surprises within the winding 22 museum rooms constructed of more than 50,000 glass bottles, while Otto the one-man-band, a captivating and rare machine that reads a music roll and plays the accordion and drum, permeates the space with music. This living museum, home to Ross Ward's 30 years of passionate tinkering, is a wonderland waiting to be explored.



### 9. JEMEZ MOUNTAINS

From Fenton Lake State Park to Jemez Falls, the Valles Caldera National Preserve to the many hot springs—Jemez is full of incredible natural wonders waiting to be explored. Across the Jemez Mountains are several locations for day hikes varying in length, many of which have hot springs or waterfalls at their ends. It's best to just go with a few spots in mind and follow the road wherever it may take you.



### 10. RIO GRANDE NATURE CENTER STATE PARK

Only six miles from campus, the Rio Grande Nature Center State Park is one of Albuquerque's premier multiuse nature trails and one of 35 New Mexico State Parks. People who meander the primary 1.2 mile trail within the 38-acre park often encounter sandhill cranes, great blue herons, porcupines, turtles and a multitude of other wildlife species. It's no wonder this is a favorite activity for locals and visitors alike.

# PERSPECTIVES AS WIDE OPEN AS OUR SKIES

Doing cutting-edge research takes seeing the world through vastly different lenses. And not just with electron microscopes or through the eyepiece at our observatory, but through the different perspectives cultivated by a rich mosaic of cultures. Our research and scholarship landscape is vibrant, complex and ever-changing, and represents a wide variety of disciplines and diverse viewpoints. These are just a few of the brilliant scholars and the vast array of subjects they're researching at The University of New Mexico.

# HERE, IDEAS ARE EVERYWHERE.

At The University of New Mexico, faculty from 115 units across 14 colleges, four branch campuses and one satellite campus lead a vast array of research and scholarship efforts. UNM is the only R1 institution in the state, a designation by the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education, reserved for doctoral universities with very high levels of research activity. Here at UNM, a vast number of research initiatives, class projects, scholarly activities and creative works add immensely to our equation for research excellence.

The University of New Mexico is dedicated to improving lives of New Mexicans. To help meet this goal, in 2018 UNM created the Presidential Grand Challenges Program that built upon the expertise, commitment and focus of our faculty and staff to address some of the state's most important issues. The original Grand Challenges research projects have leveraged partnerships with other researchers, communities and stakeholders around the state to focus on Sustainable Water Resources, Substance Use Disorders and Successful Aging. These teams have realized enormous success—including the establishment of a new institute, Accelerating Resilience Innovations in Drylands (ARID), while securing more than \$55M in new awards in just five years.

In 2022, UNM reimagined our Grand Challenges Program to expand its impact and engage many more researchers, students and community partners. As part of the reimagined program, we focused on building a culture of collaboration by naming 10 Level 1 Concept Teams and fostering them toward greater success by cultivating best practices in mentoring, partnering and team science.

In 2023, UNM named three new Level 2 projects on which we will now focus:

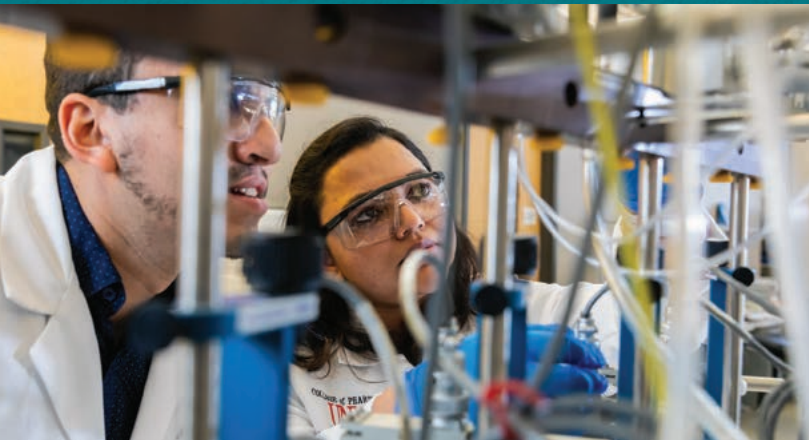

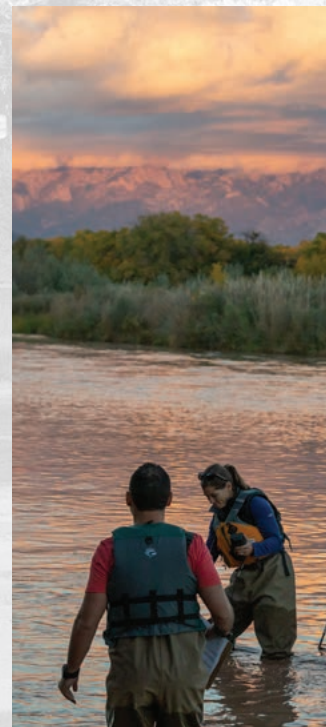

# NEXT TO THE SANDIA MOUNTAINS ON A PLATEAU BELOW A GREAT SKY

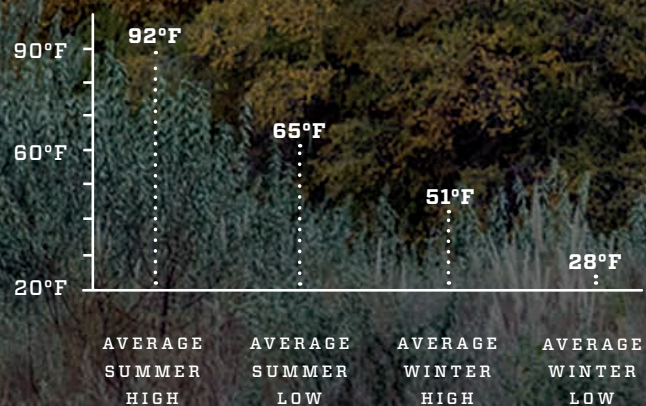
